



Film Flashback... INDEPENDENCE DAY Opened on 7/3/1996

Movies with storylines about holidays are timely when they open, but often fade quickly once the celebrating ends. Sometimes, however, box office lightning strikes, creating a blockbuster, as it did 25 years ago when INDEPENDENCE DAY opened July 3, 1996.

ID's storyline actually began on July 2, 1996 with worldwide communications on Earth interrupted by atmospheric interference from an enormous unidentified object about to collide with the planet. Unfortunately, it turns out to be a gigantic alien spacecraft that on July 3 destroys major cities around the world. Survivors head for Nevada's Area 51, where the U.S. military's rumored to be hiding a captured spaceship, and fight for their freedom July 4, making it their Independence Day.

Directed by Roland Emmerich & produced by Dean Devlin, who'd made the 1994 sci-fi adventure STARGATE, ID's stars included Jeff Goldblum, Will Smith & Bill Pullman. ID, which cost about \$75 million, opened via 20th Century Fox to \$50.2 million. It did \$306.2 million domestic and \$511.2 million international for a global total of \$817.4 million.

That success sparked a resurgence of sci-fi disaster films, recalling 1950's Hollywood classics like THE DAY THE EARTH STOOD STILL, INVADERS FROM MARS & IT CAME FROM OUTER SPACE.

But that's not what inspired Emmerich & Devlin to develop ID. They've explained the idea came to them while in Europe promoting STARGATE about a planet with beings like ancient Egyptians. When a journalist asked why Emmerich, who didn't believe aliens existed, had made such a film, he said he was intrigued by the idea of aliens arriving here. Soon he was imagining enormous spaceships hovering over Earth's largest cities and told Devlin, "I think I have an idea for our next film."

They wrote ID while on a month's vacation in Mexico and then things started happening at warp speed. A day after they sent it out, Fox's then chairman, Peter Chernin, gave ID a green light and three days later in February 1995 pre-production began.

What drove ID to blockbuster success was Fox's then innovative massive marketing campaign, which kicked off in January 1996 with the first ever Super Bowl movie ad -- on Game XXX for \$1.3 million. At the time, studios weren't promoting films six months before they opened. Using costly Super Bowl :30 spots to create awareness of a movie was brand new. A year after ID's box office touchdown, Super Bowl ads were part of every event film's marketing playbook.

Box Office Comments by Paul Dergarabedian, Comscore

- Universal's release of DreamWorks Animation's *The Boss Baby: Family Business* had a terrific opening in 3,644 N. Am. theaters this weekend and is expected to gross \$17.36M over 3 days (FSS) and \$23.07M over the 4-day weekend.
- Universal's release of Blumhouse's *The Forever Purge* had a solid debut this weekend in 3,051 N. Am. theaters and is expected to gross \$12.75M over 3 days (FSS) and \$15.86M on over the 4-day weekend.
- A24's Zola launched into theaters this 4th of July weekend grossing an impressive \$1.23M for the 3-day FSS portion of the weekend, an estimated \$1,652,500 for FSSM and has earned \$2,027,252 through Sunday and will earn a projected \$2,449,752 through Monday since its Wednesday debut. Premiering to raves back in Sundance 2020, Janicza Bravo's stylish and audacious indie has been enthusiastically received by audiences and critics alike.
- In the top spot, Universal's F9 in its second weekend domestically is expected to gross \$24M over 3 days and \$32.7M over the 4-day weekend bringing the total domestic cume to \$117.104M through Sunday and a projected \$125.8M through Monday.
- Still going strong in its sixth weekend, Paramount's A Quiet Place Part II takes the fourth spot with \$4.225M for 3-day and an expected \$5.575M for FSSM in 2,826 locations for a N. Am. cume through Sunday of \$144.437M and a projected cume of \$145.787M through Monday.
- Rounding out the Top 5, Lionsgate's *The Hitman's Wife's Bodyguard* now in its third weekend took in \$3.0M for 3-day and a projected \$3.9M for FSSM in 2,582 locations for a N. Am. cume through Sunday of \$31.378M and a projected cume through Monday of \$32.278M.
- Universal Pictures' F9 will cross \$500M WW on Monday, making it the only Hollywood title to do this since 2019. F9 adds five new markets this weekend including Spain and Singapore for a total weekend estimate of \$23.8M from 50 territories in release, for an International cume of \$374M and pushing the global grosses past \$491M thru Sunday.
- Universal's Fast 9 to reach \$35M in IMAX global box office on Monday.
- This week Disney/Marvel's long anticipated *Black Widow* opens on 785 IMAX screens in 77 markets.

After 'F9' Delivers at the Box Office, Can Other Summer Blockbusters Keep Pace? (Variety)

The \$70 million opening weekend for Universal's **F9** was a blockbuster success for the industry, beating expectations and lifting spirits among exhibitors. But lingering concerns remain, including box office prospects for the upcoming lineup of summer releases. In particular, exhibitors are concerned that ticket sales for certain key movies will be dampened by

studios releasing them on-line on the same day when they open in theatres. Over the next 5 weeks, these major studio releases will all be released day & date: Disney/Marvel's *Black Widow* (7/9), Warner Bros.' *Space Jam: A New Legacy* (7/16), Disney's *Jungle Cruise* (7/30) and Warner Bros.' *The Suicide Squad* (8/6). The jury is still out on how much of an impact at-home, premium movie viewing will have on in-theatre ticket sales. On the bright side, theatres are happy that studios are providing a steady stream of major new releases to attract those who have felt cooped up for the last year and are now looking to be entertained outside the home.





Amazon seeks new FTC chair's recusal from antitrust investigations (Axios)

The Federal Trade Commission announced that it would conduct a review of Amazon's \$8.45B acquisition of MGM Studios for possible violations of federal antitrust regulations. The announcement came only one week after the U.S. Senate confirmed Lina Khan as the next Chairwoman of the FTC. The Biden administration appointee is well known for advocating that the government act to restrain the growing influence of Amazon and other Big Tech giants on the U.S. economy and consumers.

Against All Odds, Cannes Film Festival Is Back (Vulture)

At long last, the 2021 Cannes Film Festival is ready to begin, kicking off on Wednesday July 6th.

Last year, the storied international event was cancelled because of health concerns during the COVID-19 pandemic and this year the festival dates were pushed back into the summer from their traditional dates in mid-May. Though delayed, movie lovers are still eager to experience the 2021 Cannes lineup, which includes Wes Anderson's **The French Dispatch**, Sean Penn's **Flag Day** and Sean Baker's **Red Rocket**. Vulture has provided a complete run down of the most anticipated films for Cannes 2021, as well as special attractions such as Jodi Foster receiving an honorary Palme d'Or and Spike Lee presiding as president of the grand jury.

one of the largest providers of streaming entertainment with Amazon Prime Video, provided to members of its Amazon Prime shipping program. However, it has a modest library of film and series content when compared to other media giants such as Disney, Warner Bros. Discovery, Comcast/NBCUniversal and Netflix among others. Still, by adding MGM Studios to its arsenal, some financial analysts and industry experts have warned that Amazon would add a new resource

allowing it to expand its dominant position with consumers.

This week Senator Elizabeth Warren (D-Mass.) sent a letter to Chairwoman Khan citing justification for the FTC to take an "all encompassing" view of the acquisition. For its part, Amazon expressed concern that Khan would not be able to conduct a fair review of the matter and asked that she recuse herself from having a role in the agency's upcoming review. Whatever the future holds for Amazon's acquisition of MGM, what's clear is that the tectonic plates continue to shift underneath the entertainment industry as the giants of the industry jockey for relative advantage and market share.


GOWER STREET'S *Box Office Outlook* Domestic Market Outperforms China for First Time in a Year in June

The Domestic market out-performed China, for the first time since China's July 2020 re-opening, during June. Bringing the best box office result since the pandemic began in the Domestic market, June lay further foundational stones for recovery despite a slight retraction in global box office compared to May.

According to Gower Street's latest monthly Global Box Office Tracker (GBOT), the global box office retracted slightly in June from the previous month grossing \$1.3 billion, down from \$1.4 billion in May. However, this is a normal trend and no cause for concern.

The average global box office for the three pre-pandemic years (2017-2019) was \$3.3 billion in May compared to just \$3.0 billion for June. What's more, the monthly deficit compared to the three-year average was reduced for June, with 2021 standing \$1.7 billion behind the average compared to \$1.8 billion in May (both March and April lost \$2.4 billion compared to the three-year average).



The stacked bar graph on the left shows total box office levels split out by the three key global markets: Domestic, China and International (excluding China). The pie chart indicates the current deficit compared to the average of the past three (pre-pandemic) years (2017-2019) and where those losses are currently coming from. The bar graph on the bottom right displays the percentage drops globally.

The more important news recovery news for June is Domestic growth and what that contributes to global recovery. The Domestic market grew its box office in June (\$0.4bn, up from \$0.2bn the previous two months). This is in part thanks to two hit sequels. A QUIET PLACE, PART II arrived at the close of May for the Memorial Day weekend scoring a, then, pandemic-era high opening and fuelling box office results into June.

The Memorial Day play-week went on to achieve the Domestic market's Stage 3 target on Gower Street's Blueprint To Recovery (a box office play-week equivalent to the lowest grossing play-week of 2018-2019) for the first time since the pandemic began - a major, and long overdue, milestone. The same week saw 29 US states achieve their Stage 3 targets for the first time, with Louisiana following in the following (June 4) play-week (35 states have now achieved the marker). The end of the month then brought the pandemic-era's biggest box office success, F9: THE FAST SAGA (which scored the biggest Domestic opening since STAR WARS: THE RISE OF SKYWALKER back in December 2019).

Both A QUIET PLACE, PART II and F9 (aka FAST & FURIOUS 9) have also shown the enthusiasm of audiences around the world to return to movie theaters where they can. By the end of June, Paramount's horror sequel had grossed over \$250 million worldwide and F9 over \$400 million (\$429m to July 1). F9's roster of international openings for the June 25 weekend included UK/Ireland and Portugal, scoring the best opening since 1917 (the movie not the year!) back in January 2020; Brazil, where it was the top opening since JUMANJI: THE NEXT LEVEL, also in January 2020; Mexico, where

it delivered the best opening since FROZEN 2 in November 2019; Panama, also the best result since 2019; and Colombia (best of the pandemic era).

Universal's action juggernaut opened in New Zealand for the June 17 play-week, driving that market back to the Stage 4 level on our Blueprint To Recovery (equivalent to the median play-week of 2018-2019) and delivering the market's best pandemic-era play-week. Among its June 25 openings, it drove Colombia to achieve not only Stage 3 for the first time, but also Stage 4 – only the second Latin American market to do so; the other, Argentina, repeated at Stage 4 for the June 25 play-week, delivering 88.5% of its Stage 5 target (equivalent to a top quartile play-week of 2018-2019) into the bargain. Mexico repeated at Stage 3, achieving 93% of its Stage 4 target; while Brazil hit its Stage 3 for the first time. UK/Ireland, Netherlands and Panama all repeated at Stage 3 levels in the play-week; and Portugal was another Stage 3 first-timer thanks to the F9 boost (the film single-handedly accounting for 90% of the required target).

Another contributing factor to improved Domestic performance was the continued rise in the number of movie theaters re-opening. At the close of May the market share of theaters operating had hit 75%. This grew further in June to stand just shy of 79.5% by month's end. This included the return of several Canadian provinces including Alberta (for the June 11 weekend – immediately driving the province to its Stage 3 target); British Columbia for the June 18 weekend; and Nova Scotia for the June 25 weekend. Some drive-in locations also re-opened in Ontario from June 11.

The month also delivered big news on the global front concerning market share of open theaters, which hit 80% for the first time since the pandemic began over the June 11 weekend (80.2%). It had risen to 82% by the end of the month. Renewed closures in South Africa and parts of Australia, including Sydney, from June 28 may result in a contraction, though hopefully these may be mitigated by further re-openings in Germany and Turkey from July 1.

The main reason for the slight retraction in global box office fortunes in June was China, where box office for the month was approximately \$0.3 billion – half the 3-year average and well down on May's \$0.8 billion. This meant it was the first time since China re-opened last July, that the Domestic market delivered a monthly box office higher than that in the recently crowned #1 global market!

It is worth noting, however, that May's Chinese box office was 25% ahead of the three-year average helped by a record Labour Day holiday and the earlier, May 21, release there of F9 (which has grossed approximately \$215m in the #1 global market). China lacked a big new release in June with the top openers, Taiwanese title MAN IN LOVE (\$33m) and PETER RABBIT 2 (\$25m), failing to make the market's top 25 releases of 2021 so far (which include 12 titles over \$100m).

MARTIN GROVE'S Hollywood Report

It was supposed to be Tom Cruise vs. Gru at the July 4th boxoffice, but this mid-summer night's dream evaporated.

When 2021 began, release schedules showed a powerhouse package on 7/2 -- Paramount/Skydance's TOP GUN: MAVERICK, starring Tom Cruise (pictured); & Universal/Illumination's MINIONS: THE RISE OF GRU.

Cruise picking up where he left off in 1986 as daredevil Navy pilot Maverick in TOP GUN was a natural magnet for moviegoers' money. The original cost \$15M and did a then phenomenal \$357.3M worldwide.



The first MINIONS, a spinoff of the DESPICABLE ME series, cost \$74M. It opened 7/10/15 to \$115.7M and did \$1.2B worldwide, the first non-Disney or Pixar animated film to crack \$1B.

As the pandemic worsened, both tentpoles went into safer ground. TGM landed on 11/19/21, where Cruise was to have opened in Paramount's MISSION: IMPOSSIBLE 7. GRU was pushed back a year to 7/1/22.

Universal took over 7/2 for THE BOSS BABY: FAMILY BUSINESS & THE FOREVER PURGE and they're both playing well enough with F9's Weekend #2 to keep the summer recovery going. But had TGM & GRU stayed in place, exhibitors would really have seen some July 4th fireworks.

Misperceptions by Wall Street of how badly COVID would affect moviegoing helped shape streaming's emphasis on playing movies day & date.

When the pandemic shut down cinemas, analysts saw no future for moviegoing. After a fast numbers crunch, they concluded theatre circuits couldn't survive. They claimed people wouldn't return to theatres for fear of catching COVID -- although no such event had ever been reported and exhibitors had installed costly air purification & circulation systems to protect audiences.

Wall Street loved streaming, which created a new Hollywood landscape where investment analysis was suddenly necessary. Studios saw streaming as the way to keep moviegoers who were now supposedly terrified to return



keep moviegoers who were now supposedly terrified to return to theatres.

What people really were waiting for was for theatres to start playing films they wanted to see. By holding back on big films, studios prolonged the crisis. Now with moviegoing's solid summer recovery well underway, studios should recognize that it's original content -- like Netflix's THE CROWN or Disney+'s LOKI (pictured) -- that drives streaming, not seeing movies on the couch instead of on the big screen.


